



THE DEATH PENALTY IN 2014: YEAR END

REPORT

Media Coverage Summary

DPIC's **2014 Year End Report** was released on December 18, 2014, and received excellent media coverage. Over 100 unique articles appeared in at least 300 news outlets. Headlines announced the historic low numbers of executions and death sentences, and stories emphasized that these declines are part of an ongoing trend away from the death penalty. Many pieces, including a *New York Times* editorial, noted a societal shift in the death penalty debate.

News coverage of the 2014 Year End Report included stories in the *New York Times*, *Washington Post*, *USA Today*, *Los Angeles Times*, *Wall Street Journal*, *Time*, *Associated Press*, and *Reuters*, and in hundreds of other articles and editorials. Stories also ran on NPR, CBS Radio, NBC, and PBS.

As an example of our use of new media, *The Guardian* (which now has web traffic inside the U.S. similar to the *Washington Post*) hosted an online chat about the report with DPIC's Executive Director. Within 24 hours of the report's release, tweets about the report had been viewed over one million times. Our Facebook posts reached at least 8,500 people on December 18, and their reach has continued to grow.

The theme of the growing isolation and irrelevance of the death penalty was widely repeated in editorials and commentary. An editorial in the *Kansas City Star*, for example, chastised Missouri, a leading execution state in 2014, for "bucking this good trend" and called the death penalty, "an embarrassment to Missourians." This was echoed in editorials in the *New York Times*, the *Washington Post*, and the *Chicago Tribune*, among others. The *Tribune's* editorial was widely reprinted, both in the U.S. and internationally. Its observation that, "the more experience Americans have with [the death penalty], the less they like it," appeared in papers in Florida, California,

Massachusetts, Missouri, Canada, and Korea. Non-Profit Quarterly included the Year End Report among their “11 Biggest Non-Profit Stories of 2014,” noting, “in general Americans have grown more skeptical of capital punishment.”

This year, the media picked up on the message that a strong majority of states has already abandoned the death penalty. A quote from our press release was carried widely: “The relevancy of the death penalty in our criminal justice system is seriously in question when 43 out of our 50 states do not apply the ultimate sanction.”

Similarly, the bolded summary in *Time* stated: “It has been a tortured year for capital punishment in the U.S., with multiple botched executions, last-minute stays, and exonerations raising questions about the nation's ability to constitutionally meet out the punishment.” The *Los Angeles Times* reported: “Dieter foresees a time in the next decade when executions become so rare and confined to so few states that the Supreme Court will declare the punishment unconstitutional. ‘It won't happen this year or next, but they could say it has become so unusual as to be outside the standards of decency,’ he said.”

DPIC’s visual resources were once again a welcome extension of our Year End outreach. *The Washington Post*, the *Huffington Post*, and *Mother Jones* ran our infographics, and the *ABA Journal* linked to our short video summary. These items were also widely shared on social media, with the video reaching about 10,000 people on Facebook alone. A representative list of coverage follows:
